

Privacy policy, protection and processing of personal data in the ICON S.A company.

From 25th of May 2018, we have adapted our business to the new European Union Regulation on Personal Data Protection (GDPR).

We make all effort to protect the personal information we collect. In this document, we will explain what personal information we collect and how it is used. We encourage you to read the information provided.

What information about YOU we collect and how long we will process it?

Your personal data will not be stored for longer than it is necessary for the reason for which it was collected, including the need to comply with legal and tax obligations and to resolve disputes, investigate or defend claims

Data collected in connection with business relations

When you enter with us into a business relationship, we can collect and process the following categories of personal data: your name, company you are associated with, and your position, your contact details, such as your business address, phone numbers and email addresses, data regarding our communication with you; Your interests in our products or services.

Data automatically collected

During your visit to our website, data about your visit are automatically collected, e.g. your IP address, domain name, browser type, operating system type, etc.

You can limit the processing of this information. All you need to do is to read our cookie policy and follow the information contained therein.

Data collected when you contact us

When you contact us via the website, telephone, e-mail, etc., you provide us with your personal data, e.g. name, surname, email address, telephone number, etc.

What are your rights related to the processing of personal data?

You have the following rights in connection with the processing of your personal data by us:

- the right to access your data, including obtaining a copy of the data,
- the right to request the correction of data,
- the right to delete data (in certain situations),
- the right to lodge a complaint to the supervisory body dealing with the protection of personal data,
- the right to limit data processing.

Anytime you have the right to access your personal data and the possibility of updating and changing them, as well in the case, that we asked for your consent to withdraw your consent. You can also realize any other rights that you have under applicable law, in particular the right to delete data or limit their processing.

Those rights may be limited in certain situations - e.g. when we can demonstrate that we are legally required to process your data. If you would like to use Your rights, all you have to do - is to contact the data administrator at the address: rodo@iconsa.pl.

You must remember that we may request additional information to establish your identity.

How and for what do we use your data?

Under no circumstances, we do not sell and we will not sell data collected about You to the third person.

Your data can be processed for the following purposes:

- managing our relationships with You,
- communication with You,
- sending our newsletters about our products, services or promotions, sending commercial information, with consent,
- realization and management of contacts with the company that you are associated with,
- to realize the contract, regardless of its form, or actions taken before to signed of the contract, when You order our product or service,
- ensuring compliance with legal obligations, including the obligation to disclose data.

If you are acting on behalf of a company or institution you represent, you are our business customer, contractor (supplier, customer) or other partner, You should know, that we can address to Your organization, to the e-mail address or e-mail address you provide about our products and services no matter what for consent, based on our legitimate interests. Respecting our business relationships, we provide you with the option to resign of receiving this information. By using this right, the company or institution you represent will be unsubscribed from the newsletter service and Your data will be deleted. Our offer of products and services may, however, reach your organization in connection with the implementation of our legally justified interests.

How do we protect your personal information?

The data collection process and the database storing them are protected against access by third persons.
